ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This year, the Superior Court will once more conduct its annual Mediators' Training Program through the DSBA. If you are interested in mediating civil cases for Superior Court, you must complete this training. The Court has also adopted a recertification plan where your mediation certification through the Court will need a refresher course after 7 years. A refresher course is available to view online at www.dsba.org/cle.

Mediation is often considered the most effective method of Alternative Dispute Resolution. This will be your opportunity to be added to the list of certified mediators by DSBA and the Superior Court. Registrants for this training will receive instruction in all aspects of mediation including acting as a neutral, confidentiality, mediation ethics, crafting and writing agreements, and much more. This training will include general mediation techniques and methods and will have experienced mediators working with attendees to develop skills.

Note: Registrants must commit to all three days of training. Due to the nature of mediation training, we will not be able to provide a video for missed days and to be certified, one must take the full three-day training.
